



International Broadcast Centre, 2010 Olympics, Vancouver

The Colborne Architectural Group Pacific was retained to provide architectural services for this project as part of a design-build team headed by Heatherbrae Builders Ltd. The work provides temporary facilities for all international broadcasters with rights to produce coverage of the 2010 winter Olympics in Vancouver. The facilities are built on various levels within the new Vancouver Convention and Exhibition Centre, including the entire exhibition hall as well as several function room levels overlooking the waterfront.

The total project area is approximately 300,000 sq. ft., accommodating temporary broadcasting studios, technical control rooms, editing suites, server rooms and support staff areas. Construction is to occur from September to December 2009, with removal of all facilities in March 2010. Approximate value \$18,000,000.
